Format:

Format of game depends on number of entries.

Award will be given to Champion, 1st Runners up, 2nd Runner-up and 3rd Runner-up.



Remarks:

Each match is played over 18 ends. Each team must be formed by One (1) female and One (1) male player. For each team on each end, the first player plays two bowls, his/her partner plays four bowls, then the first player plays his/her two remaining bowls. The player to play first for each team alternates with each end. The same player will therefore play the first two and last two bowls for his/her team on odd-numbered ends and the third, fourth, fifth and sixth bowls consecutively on even-numbered ends. His/her partner will play the first two and last two bowls for the team on even-numbered ends and the third, fourth, fifth and sixth bowls consecutively on odd-numbered ends. In the event that an extra end is played, the order of play shall be as for the first end. If the extra end(s) is needed, the first end shall be treated as odd-numbered end. Either the lady or the man player can play first.

- *If the preliminary rounds are played in group single round robin format. The team with the highest points in each group will proceed to the next round of the competition. Where there is a draw in the points, the winner will be decided by shots differences in the first instance. Then by the points scored in the match between them if shots difference is same. As for best seconds, if points and shots differences are the same, it will be decided by number of ends won. If still the same, it be then decided by tossing a coin.*
- *No reserve is required, in case a player cannot participate due to personal reasons, a substitute is allowed for the same gender that is not available.*
- *Only one substitute is allowed for each game. The substitute can play any position.*
- *If the substitute player plays in 2 or more games, he/she will be considered as the normal player in the team. The original player that he/she substituted will be taken out from the team.*
- *After the drawing of the fixtures, players registered in any team, even if they have not played in any game, are not allowed to be a substitute in any other team.*
- *Players can only be substitute for one team.*
- *Points scored in this competition **will be not be counted** for the Bowler of the Year Award.*
- *In any National Competitions, all players should switch their mobile phones / pagers to silent mode.*
